- If the vehicle is scheduled for repairs, please provide us with the registration or rental paper work so we can issue a temporary permit at no charge.

PERMIT TYPES, ELIGIBILITY AND APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

On-Line Applicants- All on-line applicants must upload a valid driver's license and current registration.

Requirements for Premium Permit & Limited Permit: All applicants who apply in-person or by mail must provide this letter, plus a valid driver's license and a current vehicle registration. If you are an employee or merchant residing outside of Plymouth, you must also provide current verification of your employment in Plymouth (i.e. a pay stub, signed letter from employer or a copy of your Plymouth business license).

Requirements Commercial Fisherman Permit: All applicants who apply in-person or by mail must provide this letter, a valid driver's license, current vehicle registration and your 2018 Commercial Fisherman license. Park Plymouth caps the number of Commercial Fisherman permits issued each year to 75 and they are sold on a first come, first serve basis.

2018 Permit Changes

1. **Water Lot #2 and Water Lot #3 are no longer permit areas.**
2. **School St. will no longer be a permit area, there will be 4-hour meters.**
3. **The only Limited permit areas are Water Lot #4 (near Hotel 1620), Depot Sq. and Summer St.**

Disclaimer: Purchasing a parking permit does not guarantee that you will find parking in the area where your permit is valid. Public parking is provided on a first come, first serve basis. During busy times, parking may not be available in your designated permit areas. If this should happen, we encourage you to use the free parking lots at the Jenney Grist Mill and on Water Street. If you park in an area outside of your permit zone, you risk getting a ticket for not obeying posted time limits, or neglecting to pay the hourly rate to park, in all paid parking locations. Parking is enforced from 9am-7pm, seven days a week including holidays.
